Personal Injury / Property Damage Accident/Incident

☒ The department reported a personal injury accident Thursday, August 20 at 1:13 p.m. in the area of Co. Rd. 116 and Co. Rd. 10. Vehicle #1 was southbound Co. Rd. 116; vehicle # 2 was northbound Co. Rd. 116 in the left turn lane to continue westbound Co. Rd. 10. Vehicle #1 advised they had a green light, vehicle #2 advised they had a yellow flashing light. Vehicle #2 went into the intersection, not seeing vehicle #1 until they crashed into the vehicle. Driver of vehicle #2 was cited for failure to yield at an intersection. Paramedics checked out driver of vehicle #1.

☒ The department reported a property damage accident Thursday, August 20 at 8:50 p.m. in the 232XX block of Hwy 55. The reporting party called to report they had struck a deer with their vehicle. The vehicle was eastbound on Hwy 55 when the deer collided with the driver's side bumper and side light of their vehicle.

The reporting party called to report an unknown vehicle left the roadway while driving eastbound Co. Rd. 30 and struck his mailbox, destroying it completely.
