



**Notice of Public Hearing to Consider Delinquent Utility Accounts**

Notice is hereby given that the City Council will meet to consider and possibly adopt the proposed assessment of delinquent utility fees, per Minnesota Statute 429.101 at the following meeting:

The proposed assessment roll is on file for public inspection at the city clerk's office. Written or oral objections will be considered at the meeting on Thursday, October 8, 2026. No appeal may be taken as to the amount of an assessment unless a written objection is signed by the affected property owner and filed with the city clerk prior to the assessment meeting or presented to the presiding officer at the meeting. The City Council may, upon such notice, consider any objection to the amount of a proposed individual assessment at an adjourned meeting upon further notice to the affected property owners, as it deems advisable.

Once an assessment has been adopted, you may file an appeal, per Minnesota Statutes Section 429.081, by notifying the mayor or city clerk within thirty (30) days after the adoption of the assessment (October 8, 2026).

The notice of this hearing mailed to property owners contains additional information.
