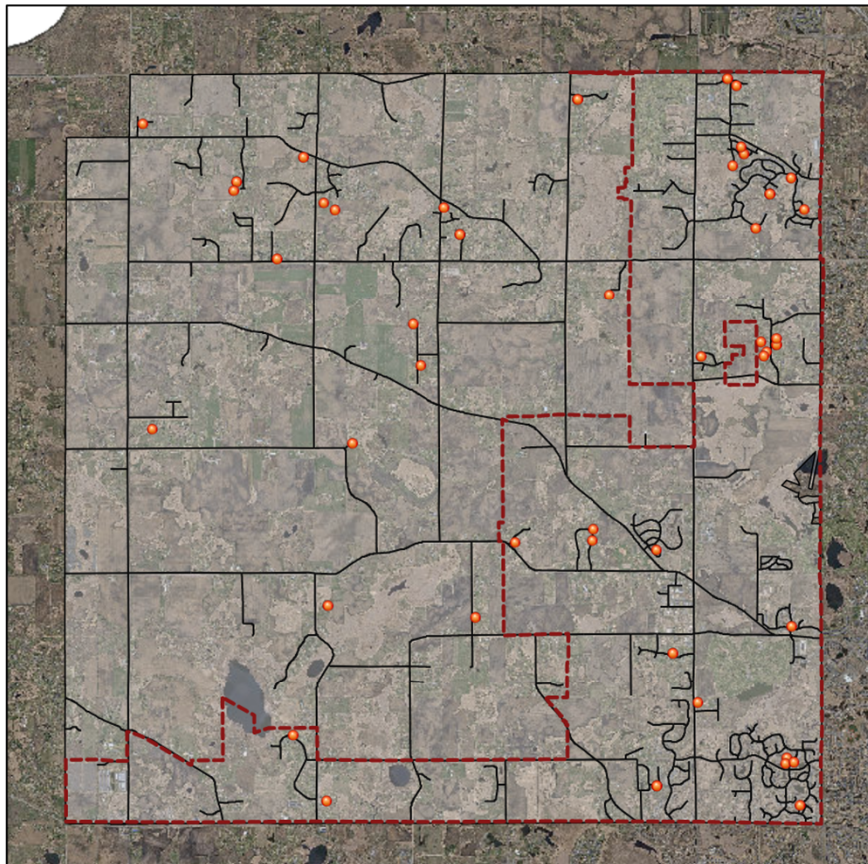

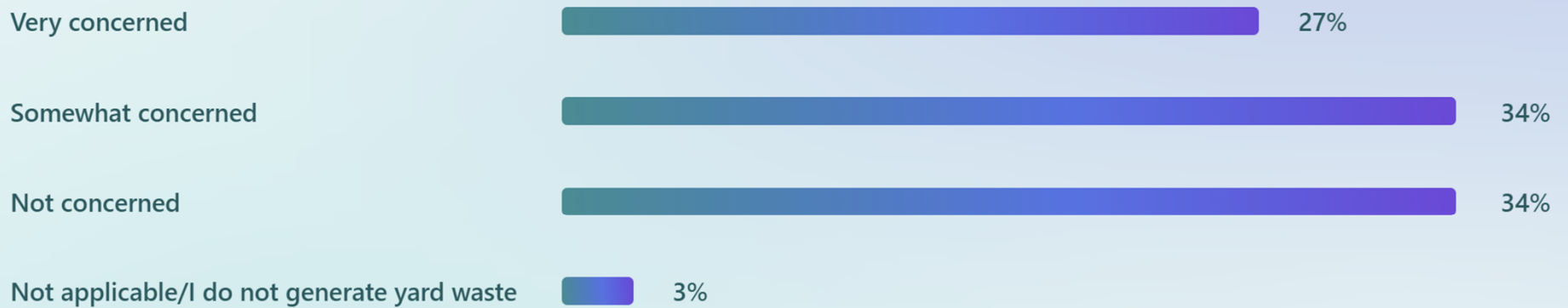

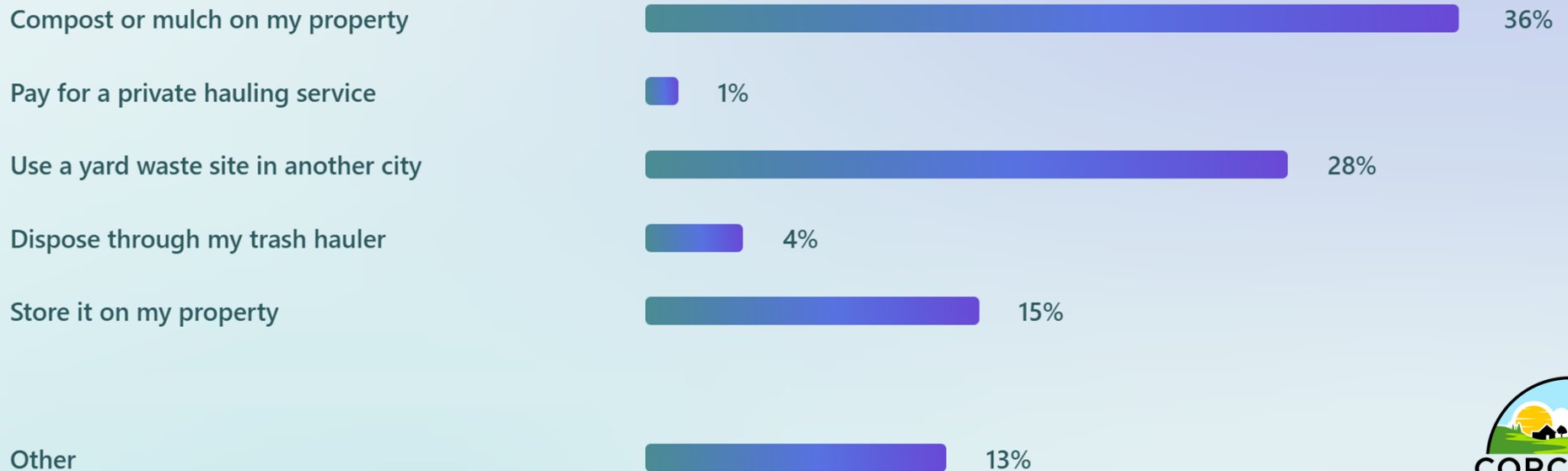
What is your primary concern related to yard waste?

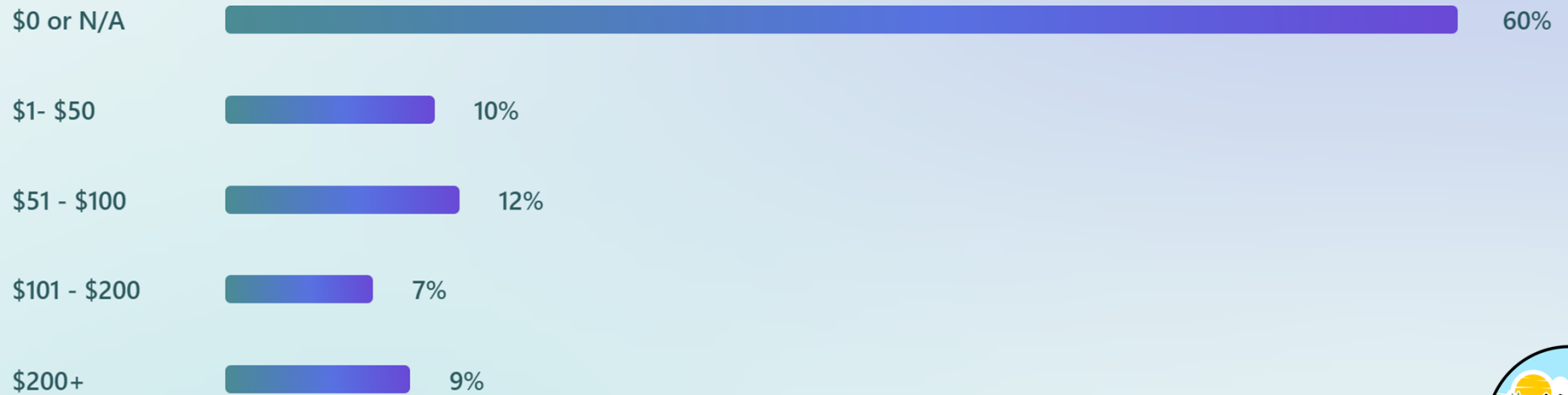
How do you currently manage your yard waste?

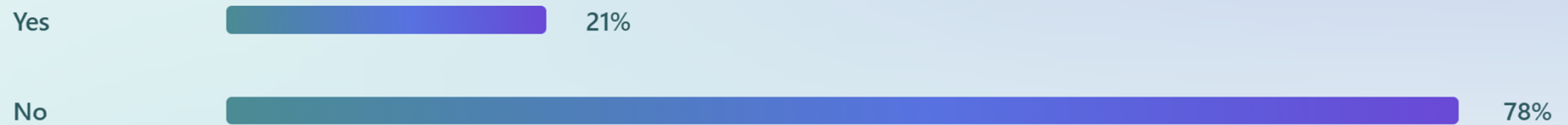

Approximately how much do yo currently spend per year on yard waste disposal or relate services?



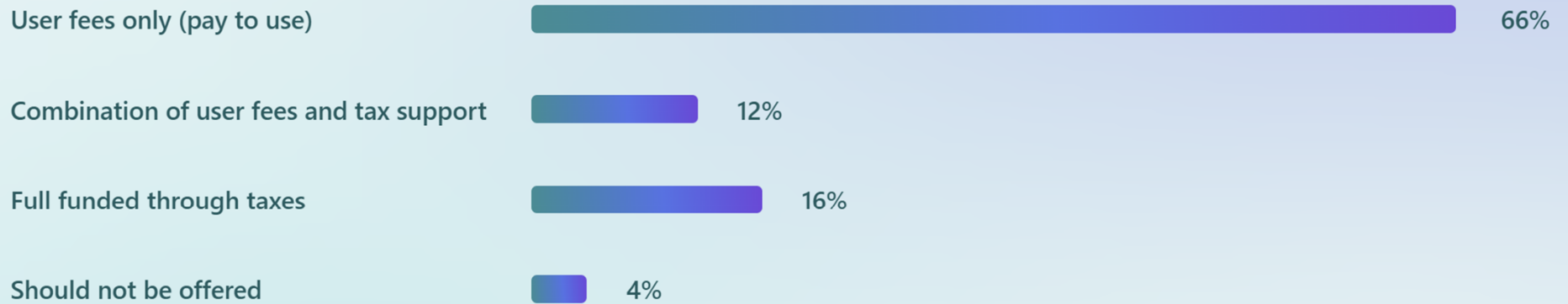

How should a yard waste disposal service be funded?



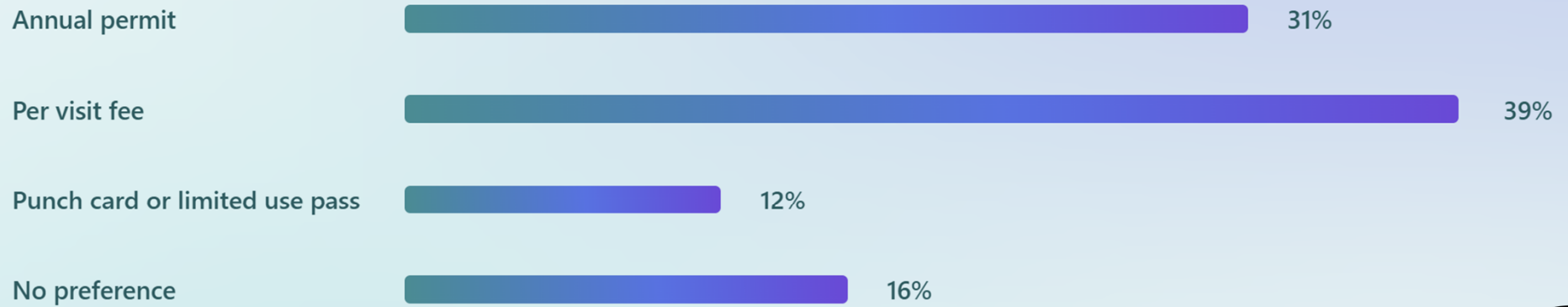

How much would you be willing to pay annually for a yard waste service?



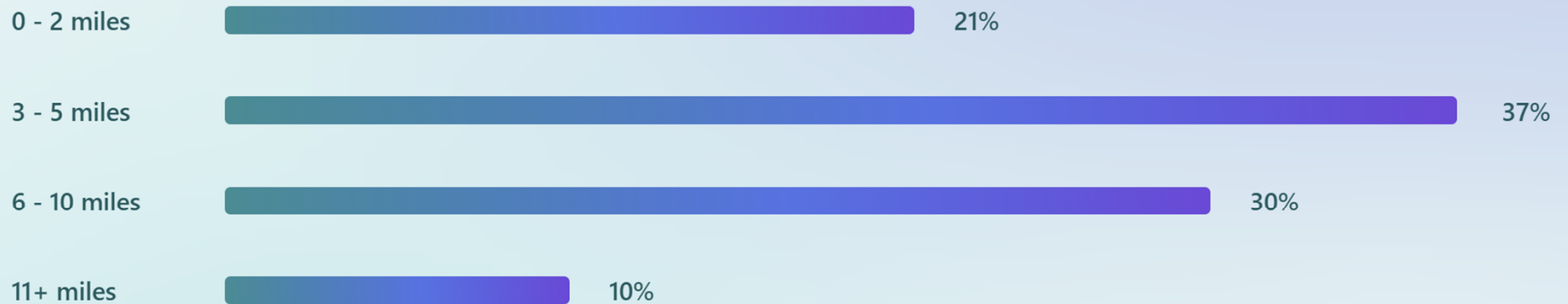
